Points of interest:

In order to protect our young trees and as per the score card, if a tree is less than two club lengths in height and interferes with a players ball, stance or swing the player make take free relief, dropping the ball at the nearest point of relief, but not nearer the hole.

Pathways & Obvious Walkways:

As per the card, free relief may be taken from all artificial pathways and obvious walkways. Examples of obvious walkways are: the worn track through the trees from 3rd green to the 4th tee and the worn track from the 14th green to the 15th tee.

Please also remember, If the pathway to the right of the 1st hole interferes with a players ball stance or swing the player is entitled to drop the ball fairway side of the path without penalty.
