Received from member:

A ball hitting the white rope/posts around the green rule needs clarifying;

I was playing in a comp last year. We were on the 2nd tee, off the whites. Another player teed off, shanked his ball and it hit the rope by the bunker on the left of the 3rd green (20 yards away?)

He then claimed that as the local rule states 'a ball hitting a rope may be replayed without penalty' he was entitled to retake his drive and promptly parred the hole. Can this local rule be amended to read that a ball hitting a rope surrounding the green on the hole in play may be replayed without penalty?

Following a similar incident, we amended the score cards in 2014 to read:

A ball striking either the rope or the posts of the hole in play, between the player and the green, may be re-played without penalty.

Without sounding condescending, (too late!) it would be in all players interests to read the local rules on the reverse of the card, they have been revised again this year.
