Rules

Another rule that might be useful now that we are playing preferred lies is rule 20-3.

Please familiarise yourself with the complete rule (placing & re-placing) but the snippet that relates most to preferred lies (especialy in the frost!) is:

d. Ball Fails to Come to Rest on Spot

If a ball when placed fails to come to rest on the spot on which it was placed, there is no penalty and the ball must be replaced. If it still fails to come to rest on that spot:

- (i) except in a <u>hazard</u>, it must be placed at the nearest spot where it can be placed at rest that is not nearer the hole and not in a hazard;
- (ii) in a <u>hazard</u>, it must be placed in the <u>hazard</u> at the nearest spot where it can be placed at rest that is not nearer the <u>hole</u>.

If a ball when placed comes to rest on the spot on which it is placed, and it subsequently <u>moves</u>, there is no penalty and the ball must be played as it lies, unless the provisions of any other <u>Rule</u> apply.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF <u>RULE 20-1</u>, <u>20-2</u> or 20-3:

Match play – Loss of hole; Stroke play – Two strokes.
