What's been happening?

- Following nasty weather on Saturday morning the men's daily mail match with Moor Park was postponed to a later date.
- The weather improved for Sunday meaning our ladies could take on South Beds in the daily mail knockout, and take them on they did..... A comfortable victory for The Millbrook 3.5 to 1.5. Well played ladies.
- The Sunday stableford (non qualifier) also took place Sunday morning. The wintry conditions didn't effect our league winners, Division 1 = Mark Abbott with 40 points. Division 2 = Malcolm Freed with 42 points.
- We require the assistance of any member available next Monday, mid to late morning (time to be advised) to form part of a work party on the course. We will once again be deep verti-draining the wet greens, assistance is required to help brush the sand into the holes. This is weather dependant.
- Work is underway with the changes to the 1st hole. The small 'upside down' bunkers have been built to protect the entrance to the green, the tops of theses bunkers will

have fescue (wispy) grass grown on them which should add to the visual appeal of the hole.

The bunker to the left of the hole has been filled and will become a grass mound.

The bunkers at the top of the slope will become grass hollows.

The new zig-zag path to the left of the slope will be constructed during March, the new path should dramatically ease the climb to the top of the slope. Players will then be kept well left of the green/approach via a path, this will enable us to improve the fringe and approach area.

- I'm currently finalising the details for our Pro-Am on the 8th September. I'm hoping to make this a similar event to charity day, with the added bonus of playing with one of the regions top professionals.
